Now Rusiness: Nurse's & Health Agent's Report for both March & April 2020

Discussion of Covid-19. The latest available information was 31 cases in Rehoboth with 1 death. The health agent has ordered that all establishments in Rehoboth that hold food permits shall require masks and gloves be worn by any employees interacting with the public. The Governor has extended restrictions until May 18, 2020.

Discussion on letters from golf courses. Letters were received from 4 golf courses asking for permission to open. The Board of Health does not have the authority to allow them to open other than to do maintenance. The Board revised the list of rules being used in Rhode Island for golf courses. The rules will take affect once the Governor allows courses to open, in addition to any additional or more restrictive rules the Commonwealth may require. Please see attached sheet for the Board of Health Rules. Motion to approve rules made by M.Hass, 2nd by T.Gaucher, approved.

Discussion of letter from Regional School District. A letter was received from Superintendent Anthony Azar requiring items remaining in the schools that belong to students and staff. The school will contact the Board of Health to come up with a plan to remove the items.

Motion to adjourn at 8:34pm made by M.Hass, 2nd by G.Kellum IV, accepted.
