Minutes: Review and sign minutes from October 26, 2021

Motion to approve made by T.Gaucher, 2nd by G.Kellum IV, approved.

Variances:

- 483 Tremont St- Outback Engineering. As approved per last month's meeting.
- 17 Katherine Rd-Landmark. Reduction in separation of SAS to GW from 5' to 4' as allowed with a Presby system. Reduction in separation of SAS to abutting well from 150' to 135'.

Motion to approve made by M.Hass, 2nd by G.Kellum IV, approved.

- 12 Circuit Dr-Landmark. The abutters' present expressed concern regarding the granting of variances. It was explained to them that this represents a great improvement over the failed cesspool currently on site. Also, the abutters' wells all meet the state regulations for distance. The 5' to 4' reduction is allowed by the state.

A motion to allow reduction in separation of SAS to abutting wells from 150' to 145', 126' 126' 118' and 103', reduction in separation of SAS to site well from 150' to 69' reduction in separation of SAS to GW from 5' to 4' was approved with the requirement that the site well be tested yearly due to the close proximity to the septic field. Also subject to the engineer verifying the invert of the septic coming out of the house and increasing the separation of SAS to GW if possible made by T.Gaucher, 2nd by G.Kellum IV.

- Contract renewal for the capped Landfill with the current company, Atlas, is offering a price of \$12, 500, which is the same price they have charged for a number of years. There is no increase.

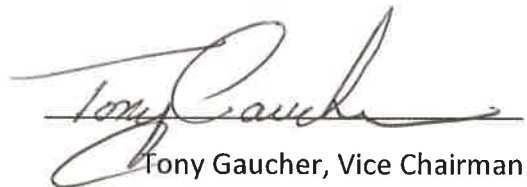
Motion to have them continue with the monitoring made by M.Hass, 2nd by K.Eyer, approved.
