- Discussion of Hydrogeological Well Regulations. No action taken
- Update on Proposed Title 5 Regulations. No action taken
- Update tobacco control regulations. The members have a few questions to be answered but thought that the regs were understood enough to go ahead and advertise a public hearing for the October meeting. The BOH office will notify the smoke shops of the public hearing.

- Update on dumpster regulations. Rachel has a draft that has been given to Selectman liaison Rob Johnson for review. She will follow up to see if this is something the BOH should pursue.
- Update on 172 Summer St
- Update 11 Kingsley Way. Grading has still not been completed. The homeowner may be in litigation with the contractor.
- Update on Body Work Establishment application status. The approved regulations take
 effect on September 25, 2023. Due to the delay in getting out the application, the
 Health Agent gave the establishments until October 25, 2023 to submit their
 applications.

Motion to approve the time extension made by G.Kellum IV, 2nd by M.Hass, approved. Also, the Health Agent is to check with Town Counsel as to what constitutes proper notification. Packets of regulations and applications had been hand delivered to each business.
