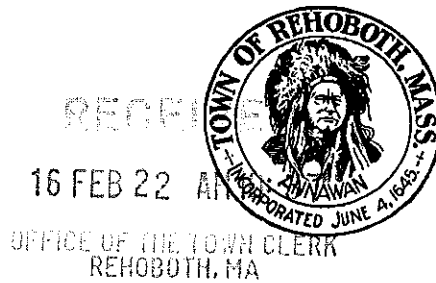

Meeting Minutes – August 4, 2015

CALL TO ORDER

Mr. Materne called the meeting to order at 7:01 PM. Pledge of Allegiance recited at 7:02pm.

CONCERNS AND COMPLAINTS

178 Summer Street – Solid waste in BVW – Mr. Materne reported that Mike Whitehead of DEP went to the site and will begin a solid waste enforcement action to the owner and recommend that the Wetland's Division start enforcement action as well..

Manitook Estates – No new information.

CURRENT ISSUES

1. Lot 10, Plain St. – Vieira – Restoration of altered BVW – Mr. Materne stated Mr. Pennoyer is in charge of the restoration and there is no new information. Ms. Bradley informed the Commission she received a call from their engineer, Jim Miller, who asked to meet with her regarding a subdivision. Mr. Materne informed the engineer they cannot proceed with any new projects until the Enforcement Order is lifted.
2. Two Key West Blvd. – Ferreira – EO – Restoration of altered BVW – No new information.
3. 187 Pleasant St. - Goulet – Mr. Choquette has not had a chance to visit the site. No new information at this time.
4. 125 Chestnut St. – Escobar – update – Ms. Bradley stated the applicant should be filing a NOI this week. The survey was completed today.
5. 417 Winthrop St. – Cartin – Mr. Bradley informed Mr. Materne that Mrs. Cartin called today saying her husband is out of town and therefore cannot attend the meeting. Ms. Bradley left a message informing

Mrs. Cartin she could attend the meeting and that the Enforcement Order is a serious matter that must be addressed. Mrs. Cartin did not return Ms. Bradley's call and she did not attend tonight's meeting.

PUBLIC HEARINGS & MEETINGS

128 Bay State Road – G & W Foundry – Solar NOI – SE60-1024 – The applicant has requested a continuance until August 18, 2015. Ms. Bradley stated there are a few more Planning Board matters to address but they cannot close the public hearing at this time in case the Planning Board makes changes to the plan. Both boards need to have the same plan before the public hearing can be closed.

GENERAL BUSINESS

1. Request for COC – 42 Walnut St. – Garcia – SE60-1024 – Ms. Bradley made a visit to the property and all looks good.

Mr. Evans motioned to issue the COC.

Mr. Habershaw seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Mr. Habershaw seconded the motion. Motion passed.

3. Isokinetics, Inc. – office chair \$131.71


Mr. Evans motioned to submit payment to Isokineticis, Inc.
