

REHOBOTH CONSERVATION COMMISSION Meeting Minutes – February 17, 2015

CALL TO ORDER

Mr. Materne called the meeting to order at 7:01 PM. Pledge of Allegiance recited at 7:02pm.

CURRENT ISSUES

- 1. Lot 10, Plain St. Vieira Restoration of altered BVW No new information.
- 2. Manitook Estates Bliss Street 40B SE60-839 EO issued 12/5/14 No new information
- 3. <u>Two Key West Blvd Ferreira wetland fill/alteration</u> No new information. Will hold off due to weather.

PUBLIC HEARINGS & MEETINGS

22 Rocky Hill Road — O'Connor — RDA — Jenna and Scott O'Connor were present. They are proposing a 10'x 20' shed in the buffer zone. It is approximately 60' from the BVW. They have owned the home on the property since 2012. Mr. Materne stated the wetland line was flagged in 2010 but not verified. The O'Connors stated there are still wetland flags on the property. The shed will not have a foundation. It will be on blocks. No building permit is required since it is under 200s.f. Mr. Nicholson asked about the tree line on the plan. The O'Connors said the tree line on the plan does not exist. They do not know when it changed. The shed will be in the lawn area

Mr. Evans motioned to issue a Negative #3 Determination of Applicability. Mr. Nicholson seconded the motion. Motion passed.

- 1. Old Providence Road ATS Equipment NOI SE60-1017 Issuance of Order of Conditions Mr. Materne stated that Fuss & O'Neill has wrapped up its review of the project and is satisfied. Mr. Prachanronarong motioned to issue the Order of Conditions. Mr. Evans seconded the motion. Motion passes.
- 2. <u>FY2016 Budget & Wages</u> Mr. Materne stated a few members of the Commission had an informal meeting with the Planning Board and discussed Ms. Bradley's wages. They have agreed to ask for a 5% raise.

Mr. Nicholson motioned to ask the town to increase Ms. Bradley's wages by 5%. Mr. Prachanronarong seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Mr. Materne then mentioned that during the meeting with the Planning Board it was agreed by both boards that they would like to be self-sufficient, which means they will have to raise their fees. The current bylaw will have to be amended to increase the fees. Mr. Materne wants to look at the last 5 years of filings and amounts to help determine new fees that would meet and exceed what is needed to cover all costs and wages.
