

#### CALL TO ORDER

Mr. Materne called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM.

#### Public Hearings

- 3. 65 Spring Street Dumontier NOI SE60-1182

Mr. Evans made a motion to grant a continuance until further notice on the above – named public hearings. Mr. Prachanronarong seconded the motion. All were in favor, motion passes.

Mr. Materne stated that there would be no more public hearings until further notice.

## Concerns & Complaints

## 1. 79 Wheeler Street - Concern

Mr. Materne stated that the cart path was considered wetlands. There is a backhoe and torn up cart path. There is also work done in the buffer zone. A cease and desist order has been put in place. I asked the owner to put up siltation control, which he has done.

Mr. Roach showed picture of the property and damage that had been done.

Mr. Evans asked were the wetland were.

Mr. Materne replied where the tracks marks are.

Ms. Huber stated he went over the driveway.

Mr. Materne stated he doubled the width of the driveway. An Enforcement Order needs to be issued until he files with the commission.

Mr. Evans asked what does he want to do?

Mr. Roach replied to turn the back part of the property into a lawn and spread loam. I told him he needs to contact his engineer.

Mr, Evans asked if the place he wants to access a buildable lot?

Mr. Roach replied yes, it is.

Mr. Materne stated that Mr. Davis said he was going to file for a limited project. He needs to file.

Mr. Evans asked if we issue an Enforcement Order can he build or perc?

Mr. Materne stated that an Enforcement Order all work has to stop.

Mr. Roach explained where damage has been done.

Mr. Kershaw asked is that going to be contiguous?

Mr. Evans asked if they have 200' of frontage?

Mr. Materne stated that the parcel had been divided.

Mr. Evans asked what do you propose?

Mr. Materne stated to have him file, seed and stabilize the disturbed area.

Mr. Evans stated he needs to stop until he come into a meeting.

Mr. Roach stated that he wants to seed and stabilize, he just needs to spread loam first.

Mr. Materne stated he needs to restore the wetlands.

Mr. Roach stated he is going to file an RDA.

Mr. Materne stated that all work within 100' of the BVW needs to stop. The rest of the areas are better left alone for now.

Mr. Kershaw stated that he's going to bring in loam to seed it.

Mr. Evans stated to have him just leave it.

Mr. Materne stated he was talking about the slope.

Ms. Huber stated that we walked the property, he knew he had wetlands and well aware of the violation. I think Enforcement Order. Don't touch it.

Mr. Evans stated he agreed with Ms. Huber. Leave it alone and wait until we can assess it. The Enforcement Order should stated stay 100' away from the BVW and he has to come before the commission.

Mr. Evans made a motion to issue an Enforcement Order as described. Mr. Prachanronarong seconded the motion. A roll call vote was taken, all replied Aye, motion passes.

# 2. 72 Martin Street - Concern

Mr. Materne stated that he had written a letter to Gary McKuch at DEP regarding what needs to take place. DEP is going to go out with us and take a look at it.

All meetings are not being held until further notice.
