CALL TO ORDER

Mr. Materne called the meeting to order at 7:01 PM. Pledge of Allegiance recited at 7:02pm.

CONCERNS AND COMPLAINTS

CURRENT ISSUES

- 1. 11 Old Providence Road, 25 & 29 Fall River Ave. Raposo No new information at this time.
- 2. 417 Winthrop St. Cartin No new information at this time.
- 3. 72 Francis St. Rodrigues BVW/Buffer Zone clearing No new information at this time.
- 4. Manitook Estates Administrative Consent Order Mr. Materne stated he and Mr. Habershaw went to the site and noted restoration is taking place. Culverts are not yet in. The replication has not been completed yet. Mr. Materne added that Mr. Grossi has stopped the work the Commission requested him to stop.
- 5. Lot 10 Plain St. Vieira EO lifted Revisit in June 2016 Mr. Pennoyer stated the area has been excavation down to the exact elevation the Commission requested. Mr. Pennoyer will contact Mr. Vieira regarding the loam and seed process.
- 6. 309 Summer St. Dalmeida wetland alteration issue EO Mr. & Mrs. Dalmeida were present. Mr. Materne explained that Nation Grid reported to the Conservation Commission that wetland filling was taking place near the power lines. National Grid has the right to inform the Conservation Commission and the commission has the right to observe the activity on the property. He added that there is debris in the wetland area. He informed Mr. Dalmeida that the stumps and brush need to be removed from the wetland area under the power lines. The wetland area is flagged. Mr. Pennoyer explained to Mr. Dalmeida that he may need a backhoe for approximately 30 minutes to remove the debris 100' away from

the wetland. He is to contact the commission when the work is complete. The Conservation Commission will go out and inspect the property.

PUBLIC HEARINGS & MEETINGS

1. 122 Peck St. – Prairie – NOI – SE60 – Mr. Jim Miller from Miller Engineering was present on behalf of the applicant. He noted he revised the plan per the commission's request. Mr. Materne stated the commission went to the property and verified the wetland line. He noted that once the well is drilled he will have to install a hay bale line across the opening and clean up the well drilling mess. He will need to replicate 2 s.f. for the well in the BVW. Mr. Materne suggested planting a shrub just upland of the well. He recommended Conservation signs be placed at flags A2, A4, A6, A25, A22 and A18. The commission will supply one sign and the applicant will have to supply the others. The Board of Health has not yet approved the septic system. Mr. Materne informed Mr. Miller he will not get his Authorization to Proceed until a new plan is submitted with flags and shrub placement and the erosion control measures are in place.

Mr. Nicholson motioned to close the public hearing.
