- Mr. Bruce Hagerman of Crossman Engineering was present.
- Mr. Hagerman presented plans.
- Mr. Evans stated that there was debris in the wetlands.
- Mr. Hagerman stated it was from a previous owner and the applicant will have it removed.
- Mr. Materne asked if the audience had any questions or concerns, there were none.
- Mr. Evans made a motion to close the public hearing.

1. CPC - Trails - Discussion

Mr. Pierce discussed creation of trials and trail maintenance on town property.

Mr. Materne stated that one of the things that the commission wanted to accomplish first was to build handicapped trails. Explained that the funding and engineering for this type of project is expensive.

7. Olson – 87 Anawan St. – RDA

Mr. Peter Lavoie of Landmark Site Design was present.

Mr. Lavoie presented plans

Mr. Materne stated that the line had been verified, it's accurate. There is a large amount of yard debris on the wetland edge. It needed to be removed before any work can start.

Mr. Lavoie stated ok.

Mr. Materne asked if the commission had any questions or concerns.

Mr. Morgan was concerned with when the debris would be taken out of the wetlands. Should it be taken out after the work is done or before.

Mr. Evans stated that it would need to be taken out prior to work being done. The work being done would cause it to be difficult to get to the debris if done after the work is completed.

Mr. Evans made a motion to issue a Negative 3 Determination.

Mr. Prachanronarong seconded the motion. Motion passes.

8. Barbosa – 71 Summer St. - RDA

Mr. Peter Lavoie of Landmark Site Design was present.

Mr. Lavoie presented plans.

Mr. Materne stated that the commission had visited the site. The wetland line is accurate. There was no alternative analysis submitted. The mean annual high-water line is not on the plans, only the BVW is shown. This is a large parcel; is this the only place you can put the septic in?

Mr. Lavoie stated due to the well in the back yard and the property line placement there was no other place to put the septic system. The USGS map does not show a brook in the front of the house, only behind the house.

Mr. Materne stated that Beaver Damn Brook does go through the property. Asked the commission if there were any questions or concerns.

Mr. Morgan stated that this property is in the NHESP zone.

Mr. Lavoie stated he would follow up on that. Requested a continuance until May 3, 2022.

Mr. Evans made a motion to grant a continuance until May 3, 2022.

Mr. Habershaw seconded the motion. Motion passes.

General Business

2. Winthrop – Morra – 297 Winthrop St. – SE60-1046 – Request for 3 yr. extension

Mr. Steve Gioiosa of SiTec Engineering was present.

Mr. Gioiosa explained why the applicant needed a 3-year extension.

Mr. Evans made a motion to grant a 3-year extension.

3. 174 Perryville Rd. - Restoration Plan - Discussion

Mr. Choquette stated that he had reviewed the plan. It was discussed on how many planting the commission wanted. The species chosen are acceptable. Didn't see any problems with the replication area as proposed.

Mr. Materne asked if everything removed off site that we asked for?

Mr. Choquette stated that the piles are still there. The silt fence had been corrected properly.

Mr. Chris Andrade of InSite Engineering was present.

Mr. Materne stated to Mr. Andrade that the three piles on site needed to be removed before any work could start.

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Mr. Ryan DuVally of Heritage Realty was present.

Mr. DuVally asked that someone from the commission meet him on site to show him what piles needed to be removed.

Mr. Choquette stated that he would meet Mr. DuVally on the site.

This was discussed further.

Mr. Materne asked if the briar bushes are going to interfere with the replication area plantings?

Mr. Habershaw stated potentially.

Mr. Choquette stated as long as the plants are a few feet away from the briar bushed there shouldn't be a problem. There are also barrels that need to be removed.

Mr. Materne spoke in regards to having a plan to take care of the grass land properly. We will need to check with NHESP.

Mr. Choquette asked about invasive species control.

Mr. Evans stated that there is a separate information from DCR on that. Until we come to a consensus we will not move forward.

Ms. Faria stated because that was where the room was and where it was flat.

Ms. Faria stated that the issue was when you come into the driveway, it was too narrow.

Mr. Choquette asked how wide was this before you started?

Ms. Faria stated 12'.

Mr. Choquette asked how wide is it now?

Ms. Faria stated we added 3'-4' more.

This was discussed further.

Mr. Materne stated that the process of fixing this needed to be started. You'll have the file an after the fact NOI.
