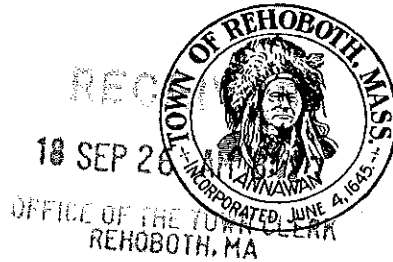

CALL TO ORDER

Mr. Materne called the meeting to order at 7:01 PM. Pledge of Allegiance recited at 7:02pm.

GENERAL BUSINESS

1. Conservation Agent-Employment Ad-review and discussion

Mr. Materne stated that the ad will be put out April 25, 2018. He asked if any of the other commissioners had anything to add to the advertisement. Discussion ensued in regard to having a salary range added to the ad. The commission agreed there should be a range starting at \$55K and up based on Education and experience.

2. Appointment of Con Com member to Town Planner/Conservation Agent search committee

CURRENT ISSUES

1. 364 Winthrop Street – Mendonca – Riverfront alteration –

Mr. Larry Mendonca was present. The Commission conducts a site visit and the follow this are to be addressed. The grade on the site needs to be brought down. The imported soil needs to be pushed up the hill. The surrounding areas are to be planted with “in kind” species of plants and shrubs. The contractor will provide the number of plants and species. The mulch can be wood chips that could be given to the owner by the town forestry department when they chip wood. The mulch can also be leaves. The Commission will need to look at the site once the soil has been graded back to sub-grade level, before top soil is brought in. All work must be done by June 15, 2018. The site will be looked at on the first site walk in June.

Chris Andrade from Insite Engineering was in front of the Commission on behalf of the applicant. The project is for a 3-bedroom house with associate site work for septic and a well. 
