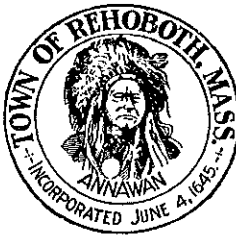

Draft Meeting Minutes – July 10, 2018

CALL TO ORDER

Mr. Materne called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM with the pledge of allegiance.

GENERAL BUSINESS

58 Winthrop Street – Enforcement Order

Mr. Richard Harris Jr. of Winthrop Street, Dighton, MA was present.

Mr. Materne stated that there had been a complaint by a neighbor. There is a steep hill. Behind the hill is wetlands and debris has been put in the wetlands.

Mr. Evans asked Mr. Harris how long it would take for the debris to be removed.

Mr. Harris stated 30 days.

Mr. Materne stated that it needs to be removed by August 19, 2018. The property will be visited then.

Mr. Evans asked for permission to enter the property.

Mr. Harris stated yes and that he will be present.

PUBLIC HEARINGS & MEETINGS

28 Medalist Drive – Ricci - RDA

Mr. Chris Andrade of InSite engineering was present.

Mr. Andrade presented the plans.

Mr. Materne stated that the flag line is off. The vegetation needs to be used to correct the flag line. The line needs to be re-flagged. New calculations need to be done.

Mr. Andrade requested a continuance until July 24, 2018.

Mr. Evans moved to continue the public hearing until July 24, 2018.

Mr. Habershaw seconded the motion. Motion passes.

GENERAL BUSINESS

5 Dean Street – Proulx – Replication Area Check

Mr. Materne stated that the property had not been visited by the commission.

2 Williamsfield Lane- Geislinger – Cease & Desist Order

Mr. Materne stated that a follow up letter needed to be sent.

PUBLIC HEARINGS & MEETINGS

29 Francis Street – Johnson & Wales – SE60-1105

Mr. Materne stated that the application had been withdrawn.

Mr. Evans moved to withdraw the application without prejudice.

Mr. Habershaw seconded the motion. Motion passes.

GENERAL BUSINESS

29 Francis Street – Johnson & Wales – violations

Mr. Habershaw stated that the property owners need to stop mowing in the wetlands and move the fence line.

Mr. Materne stated that in the backfield needs to be allowed to revegetate naturally. There should be no more use of the wetlands. All trash and anything else on the wetland side needs to be removed. South of the resource area near the fence line, needs to be identified.

Mr. Evans stated that wetland flags need to be put in place.

36 & 40 Cameron Way- MESA Notice of Land Clearing

Mr. Materne stated that because the two properties are being monitored by MESA the commission does not have to get involved.

154 Barney Ave. Ferreira – Ferreira

Mr. Materne stated that the applicant is not just putting gravel in, they are digging.

Mr. Habershaw stated that even if gravel is being used for a driveway, digging must take place.
