Mr. Prachanronarong asked to withdraw his application for SE60-915.

Ms. Skinner made a motion to issue a letter that under the new law that posted on August 4, 2010 for the permit extension act. The New expiration date will be May 16, 2011.

- Mr. Materne stated that if haybales are put down there will be no room for the trench to be put in.
- Mr. Dyer stated that it is a very shallow trench and would be covered back up within hours.
- Mr. Pennoyer asked the commission and the audience if there were any questions, there were none.
- Mr. Dyer stated that the owner would like to move the building about 5 feet.
- Mr. Pennoyer stated that it would be picked up on the COC.
- Mr. Pennoyer asked the commission and the audience if there were any questions, there were none.
- Ms. Skinner made a motion to close the public hearing.

- Mr. Dyer stated ves.
- Mr. Perry stated that when this is installed Ms. Bradley should be called.
- Mr. Dyer stated that he could have the contractor know.
- Mr. Perry suggested an on-site preconstruction meeting.
- Mr. Pennoyer stated with a 48 hours' notice to the office.
- Mr. Materne asked what was being done under the culvert?
- Mr. Dyer stated gravel would be there.
- Mr. Perry asked what was being used as a bypass?
- Mr. Dyer stated if there is flow, they will have to pump it out.
- Mr. Dyer requested a continuance until September 21, 2010.
- Ms. Skinner made a motion to grant a continuance until September 21, 2010.
- Mr. Materne seconded the motion. Motion passes.
- Mr. Pennoyer asked the audience if there were any questions, there were none.

13. DeRosa – 246 Winthrop Street – NOI – SE60-921

- Mr. Pennoyer opened the public hearing.
- Mr. Peter Lavoie of Landmark Site Designs was present.
- Mr. Lavoie presented plans.
- Mr. Pennoyer stated that the septic system is at 40'. Until we have an approval from Board of Health, I can't close the hearing.
- Mr. Lavoie stated that he requested a waiver from the BOH.

- Ms. Bradley stated that it is not on the plan.
- Mr. Materne asked how are you going to work with silt fence on a retaining wall?
- Mr. Lavoie replied they are going to install the silt fence then install the wall.
- Mr. Pennoyer stated that we are going to need a cross section on the plan. We may need an alternatives analysis.
- Ms. Bradley stated that most septic system repairs are exempt.
- Mr. Materne states that there isn't much we can do with the BOH sign off.
- Mr. Pennoyer asked the commission and the audience if there were any questions. There were none.
- Mr. Lavoie requested a continuance until September 21, 2010.
- Ms. Skinner made a motion to grant a continuance until September 21, 2010.
- Mr. Materne seconded the motion. Motion passes.
- 14. Meridian 4 Duval Street NOI SE60-922
- Mr. Pennoyer opened the public hearing.
- Mr. Nyles Nager of Outback Engineering was present.
- Mr. Nager presented plans.
- Mr. Pennoyer stated that his concern was the haybale line. Is it being proposed as the limit of work?
- Mr. Materne asked if the ORAD has an extension?
- Mr. Perry stated that the wetland line is good where work is being done. The reserve is at 50'.
- Mr. Nager stated he will have revised plans with that fixed. We have reconfigured the reserve area.
- The commission discussed the wetland line and if they could approve it.
- Mr. Perry stated that this is a previously altered lot. All work is proposed in the altered area.
- Mr. Materne stated that the line would be good for 3 years.
- Ms. Bradley stated that the wetland line is valid until March 11, 2011.
- Mr. Materne made a motion to close the public hearing.
- Ms. Skinner seconded the motion. Motion passes.
- Ms. Skinner made a motion to issue Order of Conditions as approved.
- Mr. Materne seconded the motion. Motion passes.
