*MGL CHAPTER 30A, Section 21 (6) To consider the purchase, exchange, lease or value of real property if the chair declares that an open meeting may have a detrimental effect on the negotiating position of the public body; Generally, a public body must identify the specific piece of property it plans to discuss before entering into executive session under Purpose 6. A public body may withhold the identity of the property if publicly disclosing that information would compromise the purpose for which the executive session was called. While we generally defer to public bodies' assessment of whether the inclusion of such details would compromise the purpose for an executive session, a public body must be able to demonstrate a reasonable basis for that claim if challenged. Under this purpose, as with the collective bargaining and litigation purpose, an executive session may be held only where an open meeting may have a detrimental impact on the body's negotiating position with a third party. At the time that the executive session is proposed and voted on, the chair must state on the record that having the discussion in an open session may be detrimental to the public body's negotiating position.

The posting of the above notice was made pursuant to the provisions of the Open Meeting Law, Sections 18-25, Chapter 30A of the General Laws of Massachusetts, as amended.

The Town of Rehoboth advises its employees and the public that it does not discriminate on the basis of a person's disability in employment or in access to its programs, services, and activities.
