It has been determined this is not Conservation land and not a threat to public safety. In fact he sign is on private property and that no action is needed.

G. Schwall said tomorrow there will be an Executive Session with the School Committee regarding negotiations. He also noted based on his personal interaction with Ms. McBride and not representing the view of the Finance Committee he was very pleased with Susan McBride and that she would make a valuable contribution to the work of the Finance Committee.
