Estimated Start Date of Work: Late-March to Early-April 2023

Project Type: Intersection Improvements and Related Work (Including Roundabout Construction) Winthrop St. (Route 44) at Bay State Road/Anawan Street (Route 118)

Description of Work: Roadway reconstruction, utility pole upgrades, installation of roundabout design elements, drainage improvements, roadway lighting, pedestrian and bicycle accommodations, and traffic signal removal.

Description of Traffic Management: The project is broken up into four stages, each of which has it's own long-term TMP. This includes channeling traffic as proposed in the plans utilizing temporary traffic signals, reflectorized drums, and message boards as needed. Short-term traffic setups are also expected to be utilized during work hours as needed. Both directions of Rte. 44 and Rte. 118 will remain open to traffic.

Estimated Duration of Work: Project has a completion date of 7/19/25
