Rehoboth, MA – (October 18, 2023): Rehoboth Community Electricity Aggregation is announcing the renewal of the program through the term December 2023 – November 2025. **Most participants do not need to take any action to remain in the program and receive the new pricing for the product in which they are currently enrolled. Most participants in Rehoboth's program use "Rehoboth Standard", which offers the same renewable energy content as National Grid Basic Service. "Rehoboth Standard" participants will automatically receive the new program pricing on their December meter read. Due to requirements from the Department of Public Utilities, participants in the 50% and 100% renewable products must affirmatively re-enroll in a product of their choosing to remain in the program. The voluntary renewable energy content in the Program's optional product comes from projects that qualify as MA Class I renewables and makes a sizable impact on the Town's carbon footprint. Since Rehoboth Community Electricity Aggregation's launch in 2016, participants have cumulatively purchased 90 MWh of renewable energy. This equates to avoiding over 68,220 pounds of carbon dioxide emissions cumulatively.

Over 4,200 accounts participate in the program, a vast majority of the Town's residential, commercial, and industrial electricity users. Participants have collectively saved more than \$7,100,000 since the program's launch in 2016 (please note, future savings cannot be guaranteed).
