



The Rehoboth Veterans Memorial serves as an area where the Town of Rehoboth honors all veterans who served our country. Dedicated on May 25, 2015, the memorial was constructed by The Town of Rehoboth Veterans Memorial Committee and funded by the sale of custom bricks, cash donations and in-kind service donations from residents and local businesses totaling approximately \$150,000. Currently maintained by the Veterans Service Officer along with the Rehoboth Parks Commission, the Memorial features bricks, on its outer walkway, for each conflict dating as far back as the Revolutionary War with names of veterans who served our country while being a resident of the Town. Its location on Redway Plain is fitting given the field was once a part of Redway Farm in Colonial times and was used as a training ground for the militia during the Revolutionary War.
